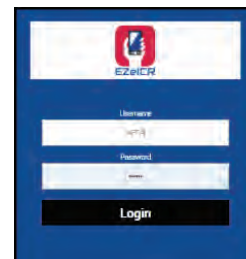


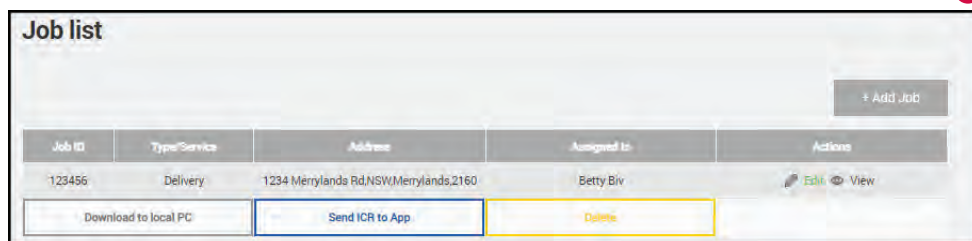
AFRA'S EZeICR System

What is the EZeICR System?

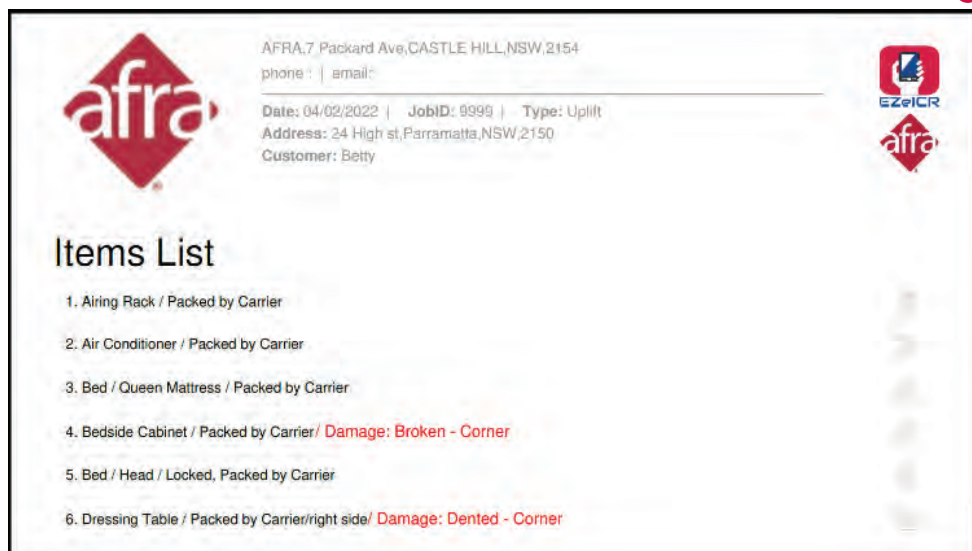
Electronic Inventory and Condition Report. The system allows the assigned administrator to enter the client's job information on a PC for a furniture removal (ie: uplifts, delivery, transit and same day move) and then sent to ICR App on the packer/removalist Android tablet. (1)



On site the packer can login to the job, enter in the information about the client's items to be moved room by room, by ticking the item on the list, who packed it, (ie: carrier/client) and item's condition eg: Master Bedroom, dressing table, damaged, corner (sample of final items list below). In addition, photos can be taken using the tablet of any items, eg: damaged, dented etc. and are stored with the job file. (2)



When the packing is completed and items are loaded onto the truck, the client and the removalist must sign the tablet to confirm that they have done a final property inspection and the list is correct. When a job is completed, it is uploaded and will be shown on the administrator PC (3).



The file can be electronically stored on your server or in the cloud. The Inventory List can be used to check off items that have been moved to the new location.

In January this year the EZeICR system was launched and members were asked to register to trial this system. This will provide members the opportunity to test system, and provide AFRA with feedback on functionality - what works, what does not what else should it do.
